Only applicants meeting the following basic criteria and completing the attached online scholarship application, will be considered for the MILLENNIUM MOMENTUM FOUNDATION, Inc. Scholarship:

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
- Applicant must be a member of one of the following ethnic groups; African-American, Asian-Pacific American, Hispanic/ Latino, or Indian/ Native American.
- Applicant must be a full-time undergraduate (minimum sophomore standing) or full-time graduate student at a four-year accredited university in Southern California. Proof of enrollment required.
- Applicant must major, and be pursuing a career in a public service related field (i.e. public policy, public administration, political science, public safety, social work, health administration, nonprofit administration, education administration, or other applicable public affairs field that allows for student to reinvest their education back into local communities to improve the quality of life therein).
- Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA for acceptance consideration into the MMF Best & Brightest Scholarship Program and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA during the duration of the program to remain eligible for participation and scholarship disbursement.
- If chosen, scholar must attend the Annual Millennium Momentum Foundation, Inc. Opening Doors Scholarship Awards Ceremony & Benefit Dinner to receive formal recognition. In addition, scholar must complete the Millennium Momentum Foundation, Inc. New Scholar Orientation, and participate in the Millennium Momentum Foundation, Inc. Leadership Development Institute.
- Scholar must make a one-year commitment after completion of the Best & Brightest Scholarship Program to maintain contact with Millennium Momentum Foundation, Inc. staff to receive academic and/or professional development guidance and support as he/she transitions into the workplace and leadership, as well as to serve as a peer mentor for incoming students participating in MMF service delivery.
- Applicant may not be considered if application is incomplete or missing required material.
