#### **LDI Waitlist Options if Capacity Reached:**

- Only 300 slots are available for the 2018-2019 Pre-Expo Student Training Series. Those students applying for acceptance consideration after 300 participants have been selected by Committee, will be waitlisted for current year program consideration in the event that slots should open up, prior to Thursday, March 14, 2019.
- If you have been waitlisted, you will be notified accordingly via email, of which we will use the email address that you have on file with your LDI application.
- If you are waitlisted, and we are not able to accommodate your participation for the 2018-2019 program cycle due to maximum capacity being reached and no slots opening up by March 14, 2019, you will be given priority consideration for the next program cycle (2019-2020).

- Students nominated by Your Turn Intern Expo / MMF partner college / university campusbased student leadership organizations & clubs, businesses, community organizations, and government agencies in Your Turn Intern Expo production territories are prioritized for program acceptance.
- Your Turn Intern Expo / MMF partner nominees may have customized deadlines, application submittal instructions, timelines, and more that are not are applicable or not applicable to info herein. With this in mind, if you have been nominated by Your Turn Intern / MMF partners and provided alternative directions, separate from these online instructions, please follow those instructions accordingly and contact our office if you need assistance or clarification accordingly.

## MMF Leadership Development Institute (LDI) Program Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be enrolled at community college or 4-Year University or College (Undergraduate & Graduate Students may apply).
- Must have cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. If not currently enrolled, applicant must have a documented cumulative 3.0 GPA from his or her most recently attended educational institution.
- Students nominated by college / university campus-based student leadership organizations / clubs, college / university faculty or staff, and partner businesses or organizations receive priority consideration for LDI acceptance and enrollment.
- If accepted, student must attend MANDATORY Leadership Development Institute (LDI) New Student Orientation, whereby all students accepted into program from all Southern California campuses (approx. 200-300 will convene on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>March 21</u>, <u>2019 at 8:00am-9:00am at Los Angeles Convention Center</u>. It is highly recommended that you SAVE THE DATE and time on your calendar and plan accordingly, so that in the event that you are accepted into program, you will ensure your attendance.

- Applicant must attend all scheduled Leadership Development Institute Training Workshops. No absences allowed, whereby absence may lead to program termination.
- Applicant must be committed to receive ongoing professional development support pre-training, onsite and post training workshops.

# LDI Graduates Prioritized for MMF Best & Brightest Scholarship Financial Aid & Your Turn Intern Internship Grants:

- LDI graduates receive priority consideration for annual internship grants (Ranging from \$1,000.00-\$4,000.00), which are sponsored by Your Turn Intern Expo & Celebrity Fest, whereby each graduate is allocated an additional 10 points in the grant application review & scoring process. (www.yourturnintern.com/internship-grants). Grant applicant required to include copy of LDI Graduation Certification as internship grant application supplement in order to receive priority points.
- LDI Graduates receive priority consideration for annual Best & Brightest Scholarships totaling \$3,000.00 (www.millennium-momentum.org), whereby each graduate is allocated an additional 10 points in the scholarship application review & scoring process. Scholarship applicant required to include copy of LDI Graduation Certification as scholarship application supplement in order to receive priority points.
